# Pap Smear Tests

**90%**

Further investigation is required to determine if the cervical cells are cancerous.



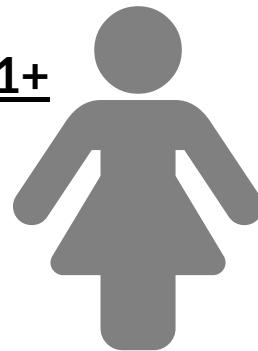

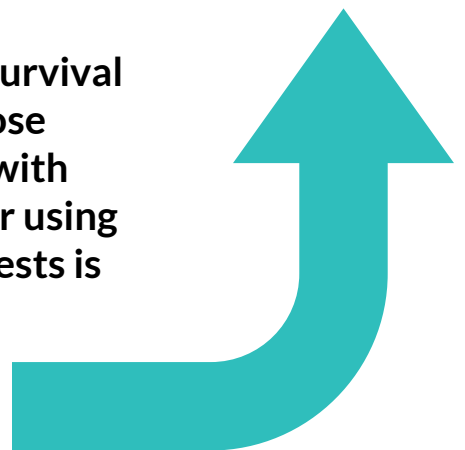
